



FINANCIAL AID POLICY

A Scholarship Committee meets as needed to agree on eligibility requirements, review applications for requests of \$500 and more, and determine the amount of assistance awarded.

To receive assistance, a family needs to show evidence of:

- Financial need
- Willingness to provide volunteer hours in exchange for tuition credit

Income Eligibility

To be eligible for financial assistance, families must have a maximum gross income of not more than 185% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines, as shown below.

Award Amount

Once eligibility is established, the Scholarship Committee will determine the size of the award based on needs and available funds.

For every \$1,000 of financial assistance received, recipients are expected to perform 10 hours of voluntary service, subject to Business Manager approval.

Staff members with preschool children receive financial assistance in the form of tuition remission. The discount on tuition and fees is based on number of days/classes worked per week. Details are included in the Statement of Benefits attached to Job Offers.
